This 100 percent confidential survey is your opportunity to tell us what you think about your work environment, your leaders and other important areas related to being a part of LMHS.

This year's survey is completely electronic. No hard copies are available. Instructions on how to access the survey were distributed in the instruction packet you should have received Monday. You can also find a direct link to the survey from the IntraLee site.

If you do not have computer access, you can use a computer in the Medical Library 24 hours a day, seven days per week. Contact the LMHS Security department if you need access to the library after regular business hours.

I know there have been some concerns that LMHS Leadership will be able to see your survey. This is absolutely not true. A third party firm, Success Profiles, will compile the data from the surveys. No one from LMHS ever sees a single survey. You do not need to enter your name or employee number to fill out the survey. A department code is required, but smaller departments are grouped with larger departments by success Profiles to further ensure your confidentiality.

Nothing from this survey can ever "come back to haunt you," so to speak, because it is completely confidential.

Please take a few moments to provide us with valuable feedback about your perceptions of your work environment. While not every person's desires or suggestions can be implemented, we do have a positive track record through the years of fulfilling consistent patterns of recommendations.
