

Lee Memorial Health System Pharmacy Residency Program

To be eligible for a postgraduate first year residency at Lee Memorial Health System, you must meet the following requirements:

- Have a Doctor of Pharmacy degree from an ACPE-accredited college of pharmacy
- All residents will be required to take the Florida Pharmacy Board Examination as soon as eligible
- Non-resident alien applicants must presently have an employment authorization that is valid throughout the residency period
- Participation in the resident matching program is required
- Application Process
 - Official college transcripts
 - Three letters of reference
 - Include completed recommendation form
 - Curriculum vitae
 - Letter of intent
 - One page in length
 - Describe your area of practice interest
- Deadline for application materials is Jan. 10
