

Mass Notification System – MIR3

If a sudden disaster impacted the Ft. Myers area, such as a plane crash, LMHS would need to mobilize our health system to meet such a crisis. If a shooter is in the hospital we would need to be to notify you immediately of the threat. How could we notify everyone within moments? Many leading healthcare facilities and other companies have already taken advantage of a Mass Notification System. LMHS has recently acquired MIR3 as our Mass Notification System. When the need arises, the MIR3 Administrator(s) will be able to quickly inform multiple groups of staff and physicians using email, text messaging and voice messages in real time.

What you can do –

Verify all information on your profile when you receive the request from Medical Staff Services. It should only take a few minutes to review your information. Please fax your updated profile to Medical Staff Services at 343-3166 or 343-2276, as soon as possible.

Privacy and Security of Your Contact information –

All contact information will be kept confidential and secure within the Medical Staff Services (PCV and MIR3) databases. Accurate contact information is the key to our success and the key to you staying informed. MIR3 Uses –

Examples of how we might use MIR3 during emergencies would be:

- Infant Abduction – giving a description of the person and their last known location
- Alert physicians and staff of security breaches and safety threats
- Active Shooter is in the building – asking if the staff is safe or if they need any type of assistance, i.e., medical attention, etc.
- Notification of LMHS Staff Hurricane Teams A & B – when to return to work
