NET ACCESS DISPLAYS PHARMACY ORDERS

Pharmacy Orders are available on the Net Access navigation bar. You may now select **Pharmacy – Active Orders** (current orders) or **Pharmacy – All Orders** (which includes discontinued orders).

To Access Pharmacy Orders: Logon to Net Access. Select a patient from the Census List. Once you are in the patient’s account, select **Pharmacy – Active Orders** to review current orders or **Pharmacy – All Orders** to review current and discontinued orders.

LMH - Ortho, 3 West, 4 West, Neuro, and 6 North.

CCH - 2 East.

HP - 5 West.

MEDICARE, ORTHOPEDIC PATIENTS, INPATIENT REHABILITATION, & MEDICAL NECESSITY

The Fiscal Intermediary for LMHS, First Coast Service Options, Inc., recently conducted a **statewide** probe audit of Inpatient Rehabilitation Facilities. The audit focused very heavily on orthopedic patients, especially those with joint replacements and fractured hips. Evidence of medical necessity was at the heart of the probe. Statewide, the audit denied 46% of orthopedic Inpatient Rehabilitation cases based primarily on a review of the patients' *acute care* record.

Medicare, through its fiscal intermediary, is of the opinion that the vast majority of orthopedic hip and joint replacement patients can be treated in a "less intensive setting" than inpatient rehabilitation ***IF*** the post operative course is uneventful and there are no other significant illnesses or co-morbidities that require a hospital level of care. This is true but a minority (10-20%) of all discharges need and can benefit from inpatient rehabilitation.

For these patients there ARE physician concerns, medical management issues, and/or co-morbid conditions that impact or could impact the safety and recovery of the patient. The need for continuing close medical management and nursing care CAN justify admission to Inpatient Rehabilitation when documented by the **acute care** physician(s).

A referral to **The Rehabilitation Hospital** is facilitated when the assessment and admission review team find supporting medical documentation in the acute progress notes and/or history/physical. The care management team in acute care and/or Post Acute Coordinators will assist medical staff with any questions regarding the documentation that is needed for this patient population.

Net Access is the browser-based application that allows Physicians, Physician Extenders and Physician Office Staff secure access to patient Lab, Rad, Micro Results, Dictated Reports, and Demographic information over the Internet.
