



Physician Patient Safety Training Available Electronically

The Lee Memorial Health System Board of Directors has established patient safety as the Number One Core value of our health system. This is very different from making patient safety a “priority” because an organization’s priorities can change over time. Our goal is to be among the safest health care systems in the nation.

Although system improvements in methods and technologies can be useful tools, the most important factors in improving patient safety remain the human ones — leadership, honest communication and real multidisciplinary teamwork to create what patient safety experts call “a culture of safety” with the patient always at the center. Training for physicians has begun across the system. The 1.5 hour CME presents the behaviors and tools that support a safe environment.
