In the upcoming months, Lee Memorial Health System will be creating a more comprehensive disaster plan to better serve the Lee County community. One of the first steps is to create a mass notification system in the event an unexpected mass casualty event (bomb/burn/blast). We are requesting the following survey to be completed and returned. This information will help us in our surge preparations in case of a major mass casualty event. It should not be confused with the Hurricane Disaster Preparedness Plan which will remain the same. *If this survey is not completed you will be designated a hospital based on need, and medical staff privileges.*
